



Clinical Inquiries Site Qualifications & Requirements

Qualifications:

- Must be a current **FPIN member**
- Must have **two local CI Corresponding Authors**. Most approved Corresponding Authors have experience writing and publishing Clinical Inquiries or HelpDesk Answers.
 - If your program only has one faculty author that meets this requirement, another faculty must be identified and be willing to work with the approved Corresponding Author in hopes of becoming the second local Corresponding Author for your program.

Requirements:

- Commit to a **2-year plan** of being a CI site
- **At least one** of the two corresponding authors must be a **clinician**. The second local corresponding author can be a librarian, pharmacist or other allied health care professionals with the appropriate interest, skill and commitment.
- **Commit to authoring a minimum of two Clinical Inquiries per academic year.**
- At least one of the local corresponding authors must **formally be an author on all of the site's Clinical Inquiries**. (They can be a third, fourth, or fifth author but they must be listed as an author and take corresponding responsibility.)
- Must use an **FPIN certified librarian** to complete literature searches for each CI. This can either be FPIN's Librarian Editor or a local librarian that has been certified by FPIN to work on CIs.
- **Peer review** at least 2 Clinical Inquiries per year.
